Application Procedure	After the student has been nominated from the home university, the International Office will contact both the students and their International Office. When the documents have been received within the deadline, they will be revised and then signed by our president. Then the International Office will send the confirmation letter.
Qualifications	proof of English Language Proficiency (Minimum TOEIC 650 or IELTS 5.5, BULATS is ok, statement from a language lecturer of your university on min. B1.2 competence is also fine), for German proof of B2.1 competence Students must enroll in the German language course in Albstadt/Sigmaringen
Visa Requirement	Students who require a visa (see http://www.auswaertiges-amt.de/EN/EinreiseUndAufenthalt/Visabestimmungen_node.html) need

	to wait for the confirmation letter. With this they can apply for a visa at the nearest German embassy / consulate.
Arrival Day	Students must arrive in time for the orientation week, which will take place in the week before the start of the classes (1 st week of March for spring semester, 3 rd week of September for the fall semester).
Airport Pick-up	No airport pick-up. We will let you know which train connection you should take to come.
Insurance	Compulsory health insurance. Students from EU countries shall bring their EHIC card, students from Turkey shall bring their TA/E13 document. Everybody else must get a German state health insurance or a DAAD insurance before arrival. We cannot accept international insurances or Mawista /Dr. Klemmer/...travel insurances.
Accommodation	We provide accommodation in our student house (single rooms only, no shared rooms). Some rooms have their own kitchen and bathroom, some share the kitchen and 2 bathrooms with 4 – 5 other students. Costs: between 270 – 320 Euros / month. Accommodation is always for 6 months: 1.9. – 28.2. / 1.3. – 31.8., shorter periods are not possible. Moving in and out of the student houses is only possible on weekdays (Monday – Friday) between 8 – 15:30, not during weekends or public holidays. Application will be done once you are accepted at our university. No meals are provided.

Students who have a minimum of B2 in German can select courses from all degree programmes.

Tuition Fees	No tuition fees for exchange students. Every student (German and International) must pay 152.80 Euros (as of 06/2024) to the Student Welfare Service for subsidized housing/food/transportation and more.
